FEDERAL PRISON INDUSTRIES (UNICOR) JOINTLY WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, FACILITIES AND ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES OFFICE, IS PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE THE GRAND OPENING OF THE NATIONAL CAPITAL RECYCLING CENTER, IN LANDOVER, MARYLAND. THIS NEW ELECTRONICS RECYCLING INITIATIVE WILL SERVICE GOVERNMENT AGENCIES AND PRIVATE CORPORATIONS IN MARYLAND, VIRGINIA AND THE GREATER WASHINGTON, D.C. AREA.

Federal Prison Industries (UNICOR) in conjunction with the Department of Justice, Facilities and Administrative Services Staff, is pleased to announce the opening of The National Capital Recycling Center, located at 3601 Pennsy Drive, Landover, Maryland. The facility will accept electronics that will be recycled by UNICOR at one of their seven Recycling Factories. UNICOR's recycling activities will be open to government agencies and private corporations within the Maryland, Virginia, and greater Washington, D.C. area.

UNICOR has been providing electronics recycling services since 1994 in response to the growing e-waste problems, generated by both government agencies and private sector organizations.

UNICOR is a nationwide recycling program with seven factories across the United States and drop off collection points in three additional states including The National Capital Recycling Center.

UNICOR will accept donations of any electronic item with a circuit card (no white goods). Below is a representative listings of items accepted regardless of their condition.
